The BSL Health Access service gives on-demand, free access to a qualified British Sign Language (BSL) interpreter in any health setting. It ensures NHS staff can communicate with Deaf people and can be used by a GP, hospital, dentist or even a pharmacy.

Remote interpreting – Available on mobile, tablet and desktop, you can download the InterpreterNow or SignVideo app or just access the service directly from the website.



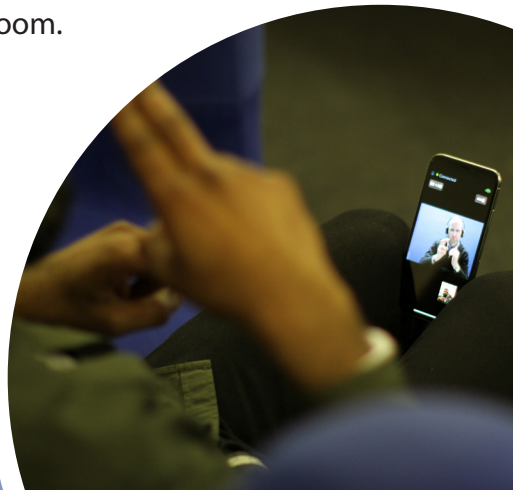
Accessible to everyone – A call can be started by a hearing or Deaf person.



Available everywhere – You can use our BSL interpreters to make calls or to help interpret a conversation between two people in the same room.



Free – BSL Health Access is initially funded by SignHealth, the Deaf health charity, to ensure NHS staff can communicate with Deaf people in BSL during the COVID-19 pandemic.
